At the tender age of 16, Pastor Phillips heard the voice of God, was called in the gospel ministry. After months of observation by his father, he was licensed to preach at the Friendship Missionary Baptist Church, Davenport, Florida.

Pastor Phillips continues to be a distinguished public speaker and evangelist who travels extensively throughout the country, "Spreading the good news".
